Meerkat

Meerkats are a species of predatory mammal from the mongoose family. It leads a daily lifestyle, usually in herds occupying a specific territory. A herd of up to 30 individuals usually consists of two or three family groups. The family group consists of a couple who are about to reproduce and their offspring who have not yet reached puberty. In the open, meerkats dig burrows, but when possible, use rock crevices..

Turtles

Turtles are reptiles. They are characterized by the presence of an armor that protects the entire torso. Turtles include carnivorous as well as herbivorous, aquatic and terrestrial species. They are all oviparous. They are found on all continents except Antarctica. The only turtle occurring in Poland within its natural range is the pond turtle.



Tiger

A species of large, predatory mammal, the largest of the modern five species of wild cats, one of the largest land predators.

Adult males reach over 300 kg of body weight with a total length of over 3 m. A It jumps well, swims very well, and usually hunts alone. A

Chameleon

Reptile chameleons. Their body is 20 to 50 cm long and weighs 60 to 220 g. Chameleons are very attached to where they are. They do not hear hearing react to vibrations in their environment. The eyes of chameleons are independent of each other and can look in different directions.



Wavy parrots

Wavy parrots are birds. Their body length ranges from 18 to 20 cm and they weigh from 26 to 29 g. They are domestic parrots that can imitate single words. About 20 color varieties were obtained.



Lion

The lion is a very large cat, second only to the largest tiger subspecies in size. The massive body with four powerful, strongly muscled paws ending with sharp claws and strong jaws is perfectly suited to knocking down and killing even very large animals. Over short distances, it can reach speeds of up to 60 km / h. He is a sprinter rather than a long-distance runner. Lions are carnivores that mainly hunt ungulates



Rhinoceros

A family of large mammals of the order Solipeds. The body is gray in color, massive, heavy, covered with thick skin, almost completely hairless, legs are pillar-shaped, three-toed, and hoofed. In the nasal area, one or two horny outgrowths, the first on the nasal bone, the second (if present) on the frontal bone. The eyes and ears are small. Skin without sebaceous and sweat glands, divided into hard plates.

Mainly nocturnal lifestyle. They live mainly alone, less often in pairs or families (female and youth). After 13-16 months of pregnancy, the female gives birth to 1 young every 3-4 years. They live in the savannas and thickets of Africa and Southeast Asia.



Elephant

A species of mammal from the elephant family, the largest modern land animal. Female and young elephants live in a herd under the guidance of an adult female to whom each family member is related. Young males are chased away from the herd as soon as they reach sexual maturity. They gather later to lead a life in a group of bachelors. Adult males live alone and have access to the herd only for a short time when the female is in heat.
